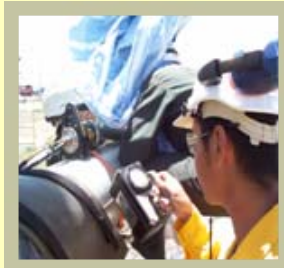


### AREA OF COVERAGE

### SUBMISSION GUIDE

An abstract of approximately 400 words should be submitted in MS Word by email with title "Abstract" before 30 January 2009. It must contain:

- Title of paper;
- Names, affiliations, and full address of all authors;
- E-mail address, fax and phone numbers of all authors;
- Introduction and Problem Statement; research objectives; methods; and references.

Submission should be double spaced, using 1 inch margins and a 12 point Times New Roman font.

Abstract selected for the Conference Programme will be notified on 27 February 2009. The final acceptance of a paper is based upon positive reviews of the abstract. Authors whose abstract are selected will be required to provide either a full manuscript or an extended abstract for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings as follows:

**Manuscript:** To be approximately 7,000 words in length, including figures and tables.

**Extended Abstract:** To be approximately 4,000 words in length, including figures, and tables

All papers will be reviewed by a team of technical expert and accepted papers will be published in journal of MSNT (NDT Spectra).
